

North Little Rock Police Athletic League Field Rules

The goal of the PAL is to offer youth in OUR communities a positive outlet by way of various sports and educational avenues at no charge to the participants. The program is run by the PAL Director, the PAL Board members, and numerous volunteers from OUR communities. The program builds character, leadership, and teamwork through mentorship. Whereas other Youth Sports Leagues charge various registration fees and other costs, the Director and Board Members put forth the effort to ensure the program is financially stable to ensure OUR kids have a place to grow.

1. General admission during the 2019 Baseball/Softball Season will be \$1 for kids age 5-12 who are not participating and \$3 for everyone 12 and older. A season pass may be purchased for \$15, which will save you \$15 through the season. Season passes will NOT be permitted during tournament games. The slight increase is to encompass the replacement of worn out equipment to ensure our participants are fitted with proper and safe gear as well as enabling the program to grow. At no point will this fee be deviated from. If you choose not to pay the admission, you will NOT be allowed entrance into the facility.
2. Games rules have been set and will strictly be enforced. All coaches will have a copy of said rules in their coach's binder
3. The coaches are parents who have kids but willingly volunteer their time to reach and progress ALL of OUR kids. At no point were you "forced" to participate with PAL, please respect the coaches and their staff.
4. Umpires are volunteers who willingly give their time to assist the PAL program. A disagreement with a call is human nature, DO NOT harass or heckle the umpires. Patrons in violation of this rule will be warned ONCE. Any further violations of this rule will result in removal from the facility, no exceptions. ANYONE has the opportunity to volunteer; if you feel you can do a better job, please volunteer to do so.
5. The program is solely for the enrichment of OUR youth. Please respect each other and refrain from the use of profanities. Patrons in violation of this rule will be warned ONCE. Any further violations of this rule will result in removal from the facility.
6. PAL strives to create a fun and safe environment for its participants. Coaches and volunteers shall adhere to the very same rules. Coaches in violation of the aforementioned rules will be warned ONCE. Any further violations of said rules will result in removal from the facility
7. If at any point ANY patrons, volunteers, or coaches engage in a verbal or physical disturbance that causes disruption and/or panic, the involved parties shall immediately be removed from the facility and face possible criminal charges. As a result of being removed for such violations, the involved parties, at the discretion of the Director-Officer Shelby Hunter, may be criminally trespassed from the property and not allowed to return for the remainder of the season.
8. Outside of the coach providing AFTER GAME snacks, NO outside food or drink will be permitted. PAL runs concession to support the program. Every penny gets poured directly back into the program for OUR youth.
9. Absolutely NO PETS will be allowed into the facility unless it is a service animal and you have proper documentation on hand.
